Communion songs celebrate (1) the salvation Jesus accomplished in his sacrificial death and resurrection for us in the past, (2) Jesus' gracious hospitality in serving us his own life and uniting us to himself, through which we receive afresh the saving power of his death and resurrection by the work of the Holy Spirit through eating and drinking bread and wine at his table together in the present, and (3) Jesus' promise to complete the salvation of his creation by returning to visibly and bodily, of which the Lord's Supper is a tangible promise and foretaste.
