WHAT HAPPENS IN WORSHIP

Here is a brief explanation of what happens in each part of the order of corporate worship at Crossroads Presbyterian Fellowship.

Two aspects of this order are important to notice:

(1) Worship Service is God's Service

The primary actions in the service are God's actions by which he serves us. Our worship is always a response to God's movement toward us and his gifts to us.

(2) Relational Rhythm

The service is an act of communion between God and his people, and thus the whole service has a responsive structure. It is a back-and-forth exchange in which God offers himself to us to serves us in various ways, and we offer ourselves in response.

We Praise God	Having been assured of God's favor, we join the angels and saints in heaven and the whole church on earth in praising God's heavenly majesty & holiness, and his grace toward us in Jesus Christ.
